# MONEY OF WORLD WAR II

World War II was the largest conflict in world history and its influence is reflected in money. From the German ghettos to the Hawaiian Islands and at home in the United States, money was adapted to fit the needs of wartime economies. As world powers struggled to conquer and reconquer territory, they put in place different monetary systems for their soldiers as well as the civilian populations. Commerce continued throughout the war whether in concentration camps, purchasing fuel and other rationed supplies, or financing the war effort itself.



This exhibit tells the stories of World War II through the coins, paper money, war bonds and other means of payment used during the conflict. It also includes several military decorations awarded to soldiers and civilians for bravery and service.
