Money of the U.S. Civil War

Before the war, a wide variety of coins were in circulation, but as the war progressed, copper, gold and silver coins were hoarded and money changed to meet the new demands of the divided nation.

This portable exhibit explores different types of emergency money such as demand notes and "greenbacks," encased postage stamps, fractional currency and Civil War tokens, plus the first U.S. coin to feature the motto "In God We Trust."

War bonds, the basis for modern war financing, were first used by the Union, and later by the Confederacy, to help finance Civil War debt. And it's no accident that the Union's superior financing influenced the war's outcome.
