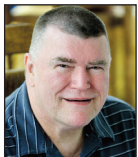

ADVANCED GRADING OF U.S. AND WORLD PAPER MONEY

Discover the often subtle differences between genuine, counterfeit and altered notes and how to grade them. In this hands-on seminar, you will improve your grading skills and learn to detect paper money that has been repaired, pressed, flattened or



laundered. U.S. and world notes will both be studied, as well as acceptable conservation methods. Students are encouraged to bring up to 10 of their own notes for grading as well as a magnifying loupe.
