The Edward C. Rochette Money Museum is proud to once again participate in the Smithsonian Magazine's Museum Day Live! event on Saturday, Sept. 27. This 10th-annual event is a great opportunity to check out the Money Museum and all that it has to offer free of charge.

September 27 is a great day to bring the kids to the Money Museum as well. Sam Gelberd, the ANA's numismatic educator, will be <u>leading a class on how coins are made in the Kids</u> <u>Zone</u>. Classes are free, we just ask that you <u>register beforehand</u> so we know how many students to expect.

If visiting the Money Museum on Sept. 27 doesn't work for you, remember that the Money Museum offers free admission on the third Saturday of every month, including on Saturday, Sept. 20.
