For each category, give a brief description of your accomplishments completed in the past six months, such as the subject of your program or article, when and where your project was presented or published, etc. and have a parent, teacher or numismatic representative verify your achievement. To participate, you must be age 17 or younger and a member of the ANA. Please make copies of this form and mail a separate form with **EACH** coin request. Check-mark the step you are completing. (some coins may be substituted due to availability)

CATEGORIES	DETAILS	VERIFICATION
1) Numismatic Program: Speak to any group, such as at school, coin club or Scouts.		
2) Exhibit: Build an exhibit and display it at a coin show, bank or library.		
3) Literary: Publish a numismatic article approx. 400 words or more. (Please enclose a copy with your form.)		
4) Service: Organize or hold office in an ANA member organization.		
5) Coin Show: Volunteer to work at a coin show in your area.		
6) Youth Organization: Earn a badge, award or other special recognition for numismatics.		

____ To receive your first coin (**Roman Empire, Victorinus, antoninianus, A.D. 268-270**), complete any three of categories 1 through 6.

____ To receive a second coin (**Roman Empire, Septimius Severus, silver denarius, A.D. 193-211**), complete any two of the remaining three categories or complete/repeat any four of categories 1 through 6.

____ Bonus: To receive a book on ancient Roman and/or Greek coins, complete any remaining categories.

____ Repeat any three categories (1-6) to earn a third coin (**Mauryan Empire, square silver coin, 321-181 BC**).

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When you have earned the first three coins, continue to category 7 for your fourth coin (Roman Empire, Probus, antoninianus, A.D. 276-282).

7) Scholarship: Complete an ANA Correspondence or Summer Seminar Course.		

_____ This is the final category in the basic project. You must earn the first four coins before continuing to the advanced portion of the project. Please note: The six month time limit does not apply to correspondence courses.

_____ **Repeat category #8** (Recruit/Scholarship) to receive coin six (**Apulia, Arpi, bronze, 3rd Century BC**). When you have received your sixth coin, you may continue to the category #9.

9) Publish: Publish an article in an ANA member regional or national publication.		

_____ Articles must be at least 500 words in length. Enclose a copy of the article, with the name and date of the publication, to receive your seventh coin (**Parthian Empire, Gotarzes II, silver tetradrachm, A.D. 40-51**). This step must be completed before advancing to the final category.

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Category #10 will complete the Ancient Coin Project and your transition from coin collector to numismatist!

10) Exhibit: Exhibit the seven coins you earned at a local, regional or national coin show.		

_____ In your exhibit, include information about the ANA David R. Cervin Ancient Coin Project in your exhibit. You may display additional ancient coins if you wish. When requesting your eighth coin (**Pamphylia, Aspendus, silver stater, 400-300 B.C.**), send a picture of your exhibit and a copy of the judge's report or other verification from a show official.
