You may begin to erect your booth at 8 a.m. Monday, August 8, 2016. Dealer/Mint set up is from 3-6 p.m. (subject to change). You may begin to dismantle your booth no earlier than 4 p.m. Saturday, August 13, 2016. The bourse floor must be vacated by 7 p.m. Saturday. More information will be provided prior to the convention as to the hours and length of time for set-up.

**REFUND POLICY:** Should company/applicant cancel this contract for any reason, refunds shall be figured from the date designated as dealer move-in and according to the following schedule: More than 90 days prior to dealer move in, \$200 shall be retained by the ANA; less than 90 to 30 days prior, 50% of bourse fees shall be retained by the ANA.

A security room will be available for all convention participants prior to set up. Armed guards will be furnished for the bourse and exhibit areas, but applicant is warned that the presence of security personnel or security systems does not constitute a guarantee against a loss. Applicants are expected to provide their own insurance against possible loss by fire, theft or other casualty.
