The winner of the American Numismatic Association's (ANA) 2003 National Coin Week Award, presented to the club or individual who best promotes the annual observance, was announced on August 1 during the ANA's 112th Anniversary Convention in Baltimore.

The Palm Beach (FL) Coin Club (PBCC) successfully promoted this year's National Coin Week (April 20-26) by conducting an "open house" at the West Palm Beach Garden Club, where the group regularly holds its meetings.
