PNG SUMMER SEMINAR SCHOLARSHIP

The <u>Professional Numismatists Guild</u> (PNG) will provide a full scholarship to a deserving young numismatist to attend a one-week session of the ANA's 2018 Summer Seminar in Colorado Springs, Colo. Dates for the two one-week sessions are June 16-21 and June 23-28.

The PNG scholarship covers tuition for a one week-long class, accommodations in a Colorado College dormitory, meals and airfare.

Young numismatists between the ages of 13-22 are eligible to apply for the scholarship. Entrants must submit a short essay outlining why they should be chosen as the 2018 scholarship recipient.
