The 2017 World's Fair of Money® in Denver, Colo. is fast approaching, and so are many of the registration deadlines for the Aug. 1-5 show, which will be held in Hall F of the Colorado Convention Center, located at 700 14th St.

Show hours are 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. Aug. 1; 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Aug. 2-4; and 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Aug. 5. ANA members can enter the show 30 minutes before the public. Admission is \$8 for adults; ANA members and children 12 and under are always free. Last admission is 30 minutes prior to closing.
