APPLICATION

Scholarship Award:

A \$1,000 scholarship will be paid directly to the school you will attend. Students with a full class schedule can receive the \$1,000 scholarship for up to four years.



Criteria for Eligibility:

The applicant must be a United States Citizen and a graduating high school senior. The applicant must have at least a 3.0 "B" verifiable cumulative grade point average as of the application date.

The applicant must plan to attend a college, university or technical trade school within the United States.

The applicant must be a member in good standing of the American Numismatic Association.

Selection Process: Scholarships are awarded on the basis of merit. Each application is thoroughly reviewed by a selection committee. Emphasis is placed on numismatic interests and accomplishments.

Tips for All Applicants: Pay attention to detail. Your application should be concise and direct, reveal interesting things about yourself and describe how your strengths, achievements and passions make you a strong candidate for this scholarship. Application Requirements

1. A completed application

2. Two letters of reference

- Reference letters must be sent on your behalf. The authors of the references may not be family members. Reference letters must be submitted directly to the ANA Education Department by the person writing the reference not the scholarship applicant.

3. An official transcript of your high school grades

- The transcript can be sent to us in an officially sealed envelope from your school, or it can be mailed directly to the ANA Education Department

Application Deadline: Applications must be postmarked by March 13, 2026
